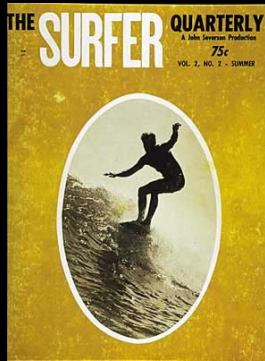


Surf Music

* Surf terminology was unique to Southern California

Beach Bunny =
Good looking girl

Tubular =
Something very cool

Gidget =
Small female surfer

Bogus =
Not cool, very lame



Sewer Surfer =
Someone who leaves their surf board on their car

Hang Loose =
Being in a relaxed state of mind (usually shown by the "shaka" sign or "hang loose" gesture)

* Woodies were early versions of the station wagon with the side or back panels made of....wood

* Very popular among surfers because they could carry their surf boards on top or on the side of the cars



* Surfers were usually spiritual individuals
